TINY STARS (AGE 4 born 2021)

ONCE A WEEK

Our Tiny Stars class combines Acro and Modern dance for 4-year-olds. It introduces little dancers to age-appropriate movement, basic acro skills, and dance terminology, while building essential foundation blocks, strength, and body awareness—all in a fun and creative setting.

ACRO (AGE 5+ born 2020 and before)

COMPULSARY CLASS

Acro class is tailored to each dancer's ability, teaching safe progressions for skills such as rolls, bridges, handstands, cartwheels, walkovers, and tumbling passes, while developing strength, flexibility, control, and confidence.

MODERN (AGE 5+)

COMPULSORY ADD ON FOR STUDENTS WISHING TO PARTICIPATE IN DANCE FESTIVALS AND COMPETITIONS.

This dynamic class develops all essential steps, kicks, turns, and jumps, with a comprehensive syllabus that emphasizes strong Modern dance technique.

SPORT (AGE 6+)


COMPULSARY FOR STUDENTS PARTICIPATING IN SPORT COMPETITION SERIES

STUDIO TERMS

STUDIO DATES

- 1. Ignite Dance Academy will open on 26 January 2026 and close on 4 December 2026.
- 2. No classes will be held on public or school holidays.

REGISTRATION & PERSONAL INFORMATION

- 1. All students must complete a registration and liability form each year or when joining the studio.
- 2.A non-refundable registration fee of R300 per student is payable upon enrolment, along with the first class fee on the first day of official classes.
- 3. By registering, parents/guardians accept responsibility for their child's account and agree to the studio's Terms & Conditions and rules.
- 4. All personal information (names, ID numbers, and contact details) is kept securely on password-protected devices and used only for administrative and accounts purposes.
- 5. Personal information will not be shared with third parties except where necessary for competitions, exams, or events (e.g., with competition organisers or governing bodies).
- 6. Inactive student accounts will be deleted to protect privacy.

STUDIO ACCESS & DROP-OFF POLICY

- 1. Ignite operates a drop-and-go policy. Parents are not permitted in classes except for the first trial class and the final class of each term
- 2. Students must arrive on time for class and be picked up promptly afterwards. The studio must be vacated immediately after class to allow the next group to enter.
- 3. No interruptions are permitted during scheduled class times. All administrative matters must be discussed via email or WhatsApp.
- 4. Dancers are expected to use the bathroom before and after class.
- 5. Parents are welcome to wait in the waiting area and accompany their child to the bathroom if necessary.
- 6. Teachers cannot leave the class unattended to take a student to the bathroom.

STUDIO CONDUCT & SAFETY

- 1. Students and parents must respect and follow the coach's instructions at all times, both in class and at any event attended by the academy.
- 2. Ignite dress code must be worn at all times.
- 3. Ignite Dance Academy is not responsible for students outside of class times.
- 4. Any damage to studio property caused by students, friends, or family (e.g. mirrors, windows, props, plants) is the responsibility of the parents for repair or replacement.

CLASS FEES & PAYMENT POLICY

- 1. Invoices are emailed at the end of each month.
- 2. All fees are payable in advance by the 1st of each month via EFT only (no cash). Please use your child's name, surname, and reference code on the invoice.
- 3. Existing students are billed pro-rata for January, with monthly or quarterly payments continuing through December. New students are billed pro-rata from their start month.
- 4. Class fees are calculated on an annual basis, taking all school and public holidays into account. Fees may be paid monthly (January–December), quarterly, or annually. Please note that monthly fees cover the full annual program, not just the number of classes in a particular month.
- 5. Fees are compulsory for all classes, whether attended or not. No reductions are given for missed classes.
- 6.If a student is absent for 3 or more consecutive weeks due to illness or injury, a credit may be applied to the following term (medical certificate required).
- 7.A one-month written notice via email is required to discontinue classes; the full month's fees remain payable. If notice is given in November, a two-month notice period applies to prevent bypassing December fees.
- 8. Fees do not include exam, concert, or competition entry fees, or costs for costumes or choreography for solo/duet/trio/group routines.

COMPETITIONS, EXAMINATIONS & CHOREOGRAPHY

- 1. Ignite Dance Academy reserves the right to determine a student's suitability for examinations, competitions, acrobatic sport, shows, and theatre productions.
- 2. Students may be withdrawn from events if, in the professional opinion of Ignite, they are not adequately prepared due to poor attendance, insufficient progress, or performance concerns.
- 3. Choreography fees apply for all solo, duet, and trio routines created outside of normal class times.
- 4. Choreography may not be altered by the dancer, parent, or guardian. All choreography remains the sole property of Ignite Dance Academy and may not be used by any other studio.
- 5.All rented costumes must be returned in good condition immediately after each performance. Failure to return costumes will result in a replacement fee added to the invoice.
